

Route Information

1. Go to the top of Holme House Road and through the ginnel ahead.
2. Turn left onto a narrow path. At the turn, go right and then follow the path uphill to the left.
3. There are places where the path gets overgrown in summer with bilberry bushes. Ignore the right turns and go straight on.
4. Cross the bridge and climb the steps to Shore Chapel.
5. Turn right onto the lane. After the houses, turn right and follow the footpath beside a wall and continue straight on between the fields. (For a shorter route turn left here to go through the woods back to the start).
6. Turn right onto Bluebell Lane and follow it past several farms.
7. The lane becomes a gravel track and leads to a huge old house. Cross the yard and through a gate. After a cattle grid, you'll come out in a sheep field. Bear right, diagonally across the field away from the phone mast. In the far corner you'll find a stile down a steep slope.
8. Cross the stile, followed by another down to left.
9. After the second stile, just past a fallen down building and a line of small trees, look downhill for a wooden post with a yellow top, marking the footpath across the field. Pitch this as a treasure hunt for the kids, there's a series of posts to find, each one visible from the last.
10. Cross another stile and zig-zag around more ruins, to a grassy path across the bottom of the field.
11. At Frieldhurst Road, turn right and then left at the ginnel to Holme House Road. Retrace steps back to start.

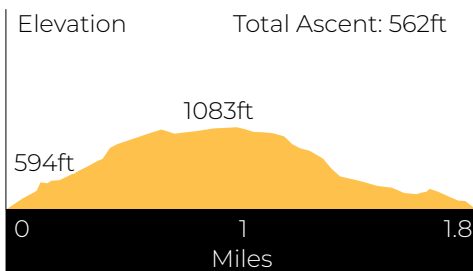
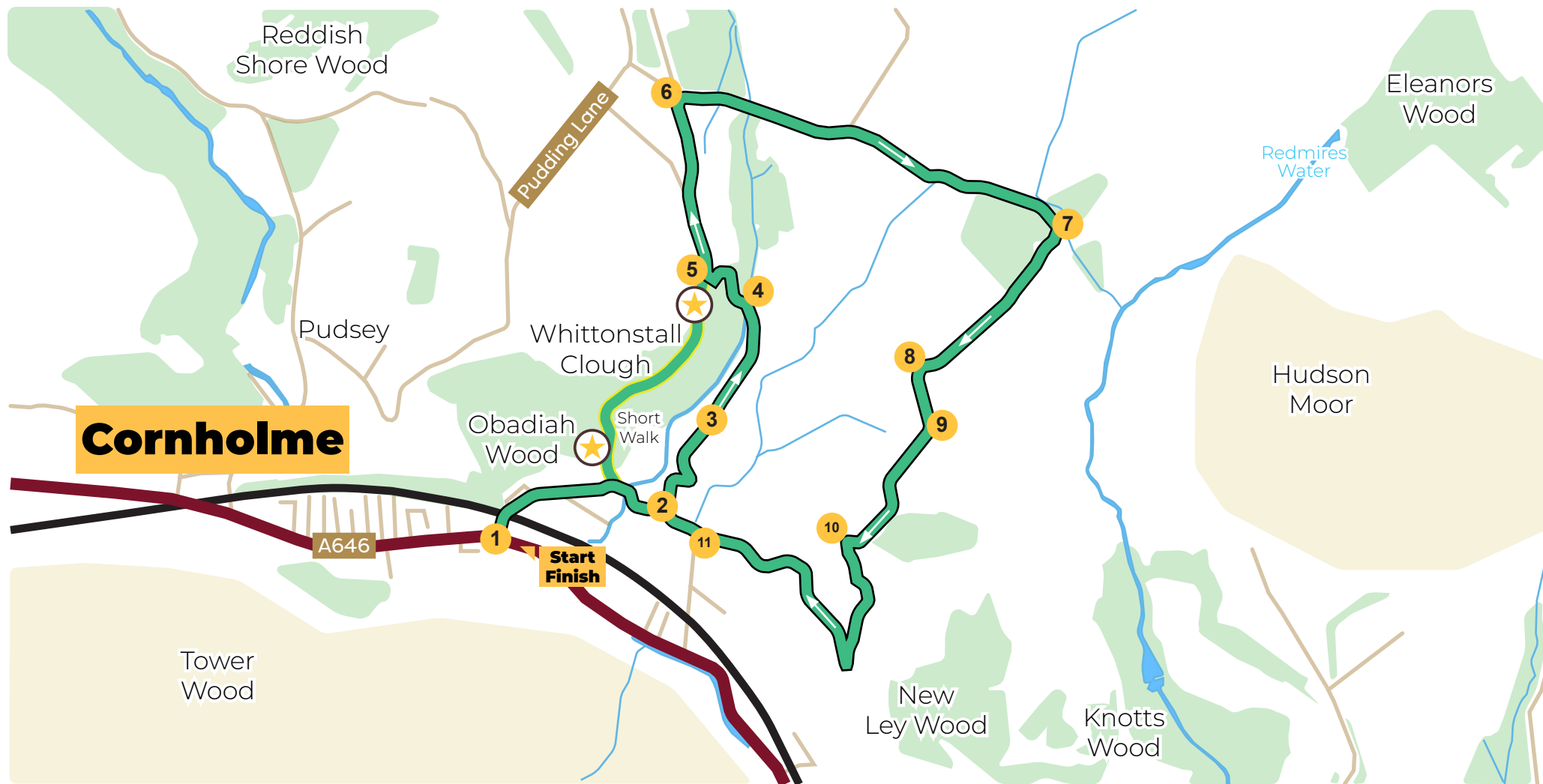
